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1. Executive Summary

This deliverable provides the contact information of each partner's data protection officer (DPO) in accordance with EU regulations. For partners not required to appoint a DPO, this deliverable provides the data protection policy.

2. Introduction

Regulation (EU) 2016/679, applicable as of 2018-05-25, obliges some organizations in EU countries to appoint a data protection officer (DPO) in accordance with expert knowledge on data protection.

According to EU regulations, the tasks of the DPO include:

- Ensuring that data protection rights, obligations and responsibilities are communicated to controllers and data subjects
- Advice and recommendations to the institution about the application of data protection regulations
- Maintaining a register of data processing operations within the DPO's institution
- Cooperation with the EDPS, notification about risks of data processing operations within the institution
- Data protection compliance within the institution
- Accountability with respect to data protection compliance
- Responding to queries or complaints on request by the institution, the controller, or other persons

In this deliverable, we list the DPOs of each partner within the project with a DPO. The contact details of these DPOs will be made available to all data subjects involved in the research conducted within this project.

According to the requirement set forth for this deliverable, all institutions not required to appoint a DPO according to EU law are required to provide a detailed data protection policy for this project. This policy will also be made available to all data subjects involved in the research conducted within this project.
